Housekeeping and Catering Policy ULSE 2024

*This policy is subject to change at the discretion of University Life Space and Events at any time. This policy is in effect as of Monday October 7, 2024.

Where Food is Permitted

- 1. Food is permitted in all ULSE spaces except for Irvine Main Hall. Food is not permissible in classrooms.
 - There are some classroom buildings that will allow for food outside of the classroom (in the hallways or lobby areas). Please speak to a Coordinator for further details

Fees

- The required housekeeping fee for events with food is <u>53.88/hour with a 2-hour</u> <u>minimum.</u>
 - a. Events with alcohol will have housekeeping for the entire duration of the event regardless of the caterer.
- 3. **Any food on College Green or Penn Commons or other outside spaces**, regardless of the provider, is subject to Urban Park Housekeeping.
 - a. The Urban Park fee is 76.79/hour with a 4-hour minimum.
- 4. **Any classroom usage over the weekend** will receive the housekeeping fee at 53.88/hour with a 2-hour minimum.
- 5. Large-scale vendor fairs (15+ tables), *regardless of food being served*, will have the housekeeping fee.
- 6. Any food that is not provided by Bon Appetite will be subject to the housekeeping fee.
 - a. Light refreshments for a small number of guests are the exception to this rule.
 Both of these standards must be met; small refreshments for a large number of guests will still have the housekeeping fee.
 - i. EX: chips, doughnuts, water, pastries for under 20 people

Bon Appetite

- 7. Food catered by Bon Appetite with a guest count of under 125 people will have the housekeeping fee waived and will also have the cost of food-display tables waived.
 - Bon Appetite catered in the lobbies/hallways of classroom buildings will still receive the housekeeping fee but will still have cost of food-display tables waived.
 - b. If the guest count is 125+, regardless of Bon Appetite catering, the event will receive the housekeeping fee but will still have cost of food-display tables waived.
